SAMPLE SCHEDULE

Monday- Welcome and Safety Orientation:) Lay out your brushes in order with bareback pad and bridle. Learn how to safely halter and groom then tack up your mount. Western reins steering, back up, whoa! Muck stalls and put in new bedding! Lasso plastic bull and tie knots!

Tuesday- Western trail learning poisonous plants (castor bean, morning glory, poison oak) along with edible plants (blackberries, boysenberries, fennel, lemon berries).

Learn tack parts (of English and Western saddles & bridles), cleaning tack, and lasso some more!

Wednesday- English reins learning how to steer, rein back, and halt, plus proper English position! Learn about feed and hay, also Tiffany shows how to trim a horses' hooves while learning about the farrier's tools!

Thursday- English on trail finding California sage, fig plants and wild cucumbers. Anatomy of a horse along with identifying horse colors and breeds for all of our horses plus horsemen's terms!

UNIQUE DAILY PHOTOS AND JOURNALING

One really unique aspect of our camp is the documentation. The collection of riders' daily journaling, Instructor's emails, plus the action photos we take at camp riding and hands-on learning around the barn. We email a link to pics and journal entries to share the memories with families!

WHAT TO WEAR

1. NO CANCELLATIONS NOR RESCHEDULING, regardless of reason (illness, emergency, no show, etc.).

We save Equines for and rely on Riders to care for and ride their mounts each week and set up for success by scheduling in advance to stay in business doing what we love. Thank you for your help and consideration, we appreciate it!

2. LESSONS RUN RAIN OR SHINE! Rider may opt to handwalk instead of ride if too rainy/muddy, as their reserved Equine still needs daily TLC, care, and especially exercise. Slow riding is good for working on aids (seat, hands, legs).

3. LESSONS ARE PREPAID BY THE MONTH, providing one week off for Equines and Instructors.

RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I, _____, in consideration for the privilege of taking horseback riding lessons from Tiffany Chiu and Associates (Instructors, Assistants, Helpers, Volunteers), leasing, and being present on the premises, located at 26730 Eastvale Road, Palos Verdes Peninsula, California, owned by Colin Chiu, and in the City of Rolling Hills Estates, agree to assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in using, riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury and/or death from using, riding or being in close proximity to horses.

I, and any persons accompanying me, agree to comply with the barn and arena rules.

I agree to and do release, discharge and promise not to sue Tiffany Chiu, Associates, Colin Chiu, and the City of Rolling Hills Estates for any loss, liability, damage, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property or any horse owned by me or to any family member or spectator accompanying me, whether such may occur on the premises or elsewhere.

Further, I agree to and promise to indemnify and save and hold harmless Tiffany Chiu, Associates, Colin Chiu, and the City of Rolling Hills Estates from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with riding lessons or with my presence on the premises or with the presence on the premises of any person accompanying me.
